The boys and girls have done a great job during this month, adjusting to our daily routine, making crafts and getting messy with different activities, along learning about shapes color and numbers, during last month topics of 'Shapes, Colors, and Numbers'; 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and 'Halloween'.

Next month our learning topic will be 'Transport' (two weeks) and 'Nursery Rhymes'.

During the 'Transport' topic children will learn that vehicles are used for moving from one place to another and that people use vehicles as transportation, or as ways to move around. Also to be able to speak in the target language whether a particular mode of transport flies in the air or moves on the road or in water.
