Develop language and literacy skills

Develop communication skills as it helps them learn new vocabulary or numeracy

Enhances physical development when actions are linked to words in the nursery rhyme, it helps boost motor skills and improves rhythm and movement

Helps develop cognitive skills as improves memory, concentration, spatial intelligence, and thinking skills

Enhances individual development as music helps develop children with better self-control.

The Dinosaurs' topic offers endless activities and adventures for children. We will focus more on sensory play activities, as well as what sounds dinosaurs can make by enhancing children's vocabulary such as the concept "Big" & "Small".
