I would like to thank you for sending in pictures of beloved families to help us create a foundation for learning more about your children.



During October we will be looking at the topics 'ABC; Shapes, Numbers and Colors'. We will start practising recognition of numbers from 1-10, prime colours and shapes as (circle, diamond, square, star, rectangle, oval, and heart). The topic will allow me to provide games and equipment that offers children the opportunity for active learning and incorporate its component in areas such as the sand, water or other play areas.

We will start using comparisons between quantities as well as using the language of quantities, such as 'more' and 'a lot'.

At home, you can help the children to notices simple shapes and patterns in pictures and your daily routine, e.g. square/ rectangle which emerges as you fold or unfold a tablecloth or napkin; circle when comes to dinner plates etc., and encouraging you to use descriptive words like 'big' and 'little'.
