

STARGAZERS OCTOBER NEWSLETTER

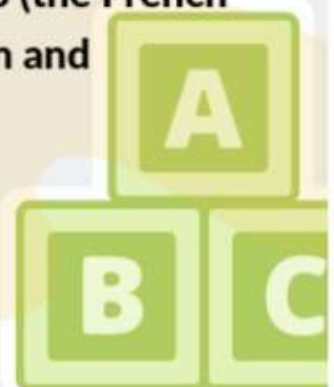
Dear Parents,

The start of the new school year has been so far a very successful ride for our new students in the FS1 Stargazers class! They have done so well to settle in so quickly and get used to the new, exciting rhythm of the final class at Rainbow Valley Nursery.

The first few weeks of the month have been focused on helping to get the children settled into the new classroom, with their new teachers and new classmates. As expected, some of them were quite daunted by their new experience but have quickly become happy to see their friends at Nursery every day as they now feel safe and secure in their environment.

Mid-September we started our curriculum subjects with 'All About Me' where we looked at My Family, My Feelings, The 5 Senses, My Body and My Pets. These topics have encouraged the children to see and understand the world around them and have helped them talk about people and things that are important to them in their everyday lives. Their vocabulary has also been broadened by introducing new ideas and concepts as with the senses of touch, taste, sight, hearing, and smell.

As the children will be now following the FS1 curriculum, the program is more structured with the beginning of their phonics and math lessons which have started this month. We have also begun our Arabic and French classes with our special guest French teacher Cocorico (the French chicken) to enhance the children's learning experience in a fun and different way!



For the following month, we will be looking at the topics 'ABC and the Phonetic Alphabet, Shapes, Numbers, and Colors'. This will work on the children's math, expressive art and design and literacy skills and develop them through interesting and intriguing activities.
